- The Johnson & Johnson “FLDP” was a two-year leadership development program that recruited about 100 people, many having already worked for Johnson & Johnson as paid interns and employees, to complete two one-year full-time employment rotations in various sectors and in various areas of corporate finance to learn how to become future leaders of the large international publicly-traded company.
- I was hired as the first overall draft selection by Ethicon, the first-ever Johnson & Johnson operating company, to join a recently-acquired aesthetics and medical device company in Santa Barbara, CA with a **compensation package that included ~\$60,000 USD salary + multiplied overtime pay of uncapped hours worked beyond 40/week + sign-on bonus +**

year-end bonus + relocation package that included cash + a corporate card for expenses + guaranteed automatic promotions up through six months after the program ends to ~\$80,000 USD.

- During the program, I achieved a CMA which is a certification in budgeting and financial analysis that was paid for by J&J and incentivized with a bonus upon completion, and was one of select FLDP graduates to have supervising responsibilities immediately after the program ended. I decided to leave the program to seek higher paying opportunities in larger cities.

- Please note that while this was not my hiring company, I swapped with someone into this location to be closer to major cities on the east coast where I wanted to work and seek higher pay, such as Manhattan and Miami. I decided to leave the company after I was placed in Pennsylvania as my second rotation after specific requests to not be put in Pennsylvania. The final automatic promotion of the FLDP was 2.5 years from the start date (~December 2013).
- Analyzed OTC (over-the-counter) performance from a supply chain and operations perspective
- Prepared supply chain results decks and attended leadership reviews that included the CFO and head of all Operations
- Shared supervisor responsibilities, managing a full-time co-op, whom I was permitted to bring with me to attend leadership meetings, have take notes, and have manage the more secretarial aspects such as scheduling, and the organization and presentation of slides
- After alleged confusion of my identity, presumably with a person I swapped positions with to stay near larger cities in which I wanted to work, I decided to interview for jobs in Miami and Manhattan and leave J&J because of their locations in remote rural areas. I received a letter of job abandonment while at my mother's house in North New Jersey interviewing for a job in Manhattan while using my available accumulated Paid Time Off days. Since a private investigator was used to stalk me and track me down at my mother's house with irrational allegations that I was a "mole" and accusations of being interested in stealing the company's laptop after refusing to send a shipping label, a laptop we were allowed to carry with us to work from home with, I chose to not take my job back as offered, and relocated to Miami, FL.

- Companies I worked at through temporary independent contractor agreements include brand names such as Bayer, Grunenthal Latin America, and various smaller-sized companies. All consulting contracts were through American employers, including consulting agencies such as Robert Half Management Resources, even if the position involved working at German healthcare companies.
- Hired as a temporary Independent Contractor in capacities including financial management support, Excel modeling, sales management support, tech and database integration, and strategic sourcing.
- Completed a full-time employment for exactly one year, from April 20, 2015 to April 19, 2016, at a publicly-traded company that was already announced to be getting acquired, and my job involved supporting the sales teams, marketing directors, and being lead finance of the Retail Store Optimization Plan, analyzing market competitiveness while the FTC was determining whether the acquisition would be approved. I found an indisputable and acknowledged technical malfunction in the Retail Optimization spreadsheets (Excel) model, built by Bain Consulting, that I took over from a senior

financial analyst that was hired the same day as me, which was a result of not properly maintaining the model and significantly changed results reported as one of the company's key strategic priorities, with my findings changing the results to show a duopoly environment; the acquisition was denied by the FTC shortly after and my job was eliminated.

- Upon concluding the above-mentioned full-time one-year employment, I was offered an IC agreement with Kaiser Permanente in California, but the contract was terminated during the group onboarding before the job started. There was no misconduct, absence, tardiness, nor any other type of reason involving job performance. I was then injured in Los Angeles as a result of a theft of my phone that required surgery, for which I was approved for an initial period of one year of state disability income, though I decided to attempt working instead during the disability period.

2017 Started Physical Disability Period

Disabled and received state disability insurance compensation after suffering multiple knife wounds resulting from a theft of my phone while on vacation visiting Los Angeles for the first time for my birthday. One of the knife wounds hit my spinal area and resulted in surgery and a prolonged recovery requiring avoidance of cold temperatures.

- This contract was attempted during the approved physical disability period, but my symptoms were preventing me from going into the office, and my temp contract as a finance manager ended while I was attempting to work remotely. Since my disability compensation was stopped, and I needed to avoid cold temperatures because of my physical disability, my decision was to relocate to low-cost hot areas of the world and attempt to work remotely part-time while I recovered.

- Responsible for the development of a proprietary ledger and budgeting utility offered through a web app, permitting four levels of hierarchies in submitting budgets and cashflows into an insert-only cashflow ledger that feeds a BI utility that automatically generates dynamic P&Ls, proformas, and BvA analyses. The BI and cashflow system is professional grade and liberal, allowing flexible analyses, including single day variances, dynamic slicing of income statement views of actual and budgeted results, as well as the variances, and a unique recurring cashflow system enables analyzing upcoming recurring cashflows, and provides variances and proformas from single day to more than 10 years out.
- Hired, negotiated pay, and formulated individual IC employment agreements with wellness experts such as nutritionists and yoga instructors to provide freelance services to customers through a proprietary app allowing them to connect with clients to provide diets, videos, and instructions, as well as create plans to market, schedule video consultations/classes, and bid on ad-hoc requests that may come through for immediate-pay tasks. Hired IC freelance doctors to write international medical/nutrition blogs. Worked with digital design experts to come up with properly branded design work that fits appropriate value themes. Hired independent contractor experts in areas of iOS and Google Play Android app development to assist with adding enhancements to already-developed mobile apps.
- Led the development and launch of various brands, including Well n Tell, being responsible for all areas of business development, talent contracting, and operation, built in order to have the same dynamic feel of JavaScript sites without the risk and potential lack of reliability of script tags, with JavaScript being offered as optional only, isolated and excluded by default yet can be activated by the user clicking the option to enable the JavaScript version of the page. With prioritization of reliability, the decision was to not use any 3rd party libraries, JavaScript frameworks, templates, nor any other form of external code, including fonts and popular formatting utilities, and with no links to any external sources aside from integration with a videoconferencing company and payment APIs, such as Stripe, which resulted in acquiring expertise at a sufficient level in custom HTML/CSS design, proprietary logic in server-side technologies, and database integration and management using insert-only databases and size-reducing databases concurrently.

Please note that this app permits me to schedule optional group classes and consultations at my discretion, which will be treated secondary to my education and primary employment. Other side endeavors have included gigs such as leveraging my international nutrition and culture expertise, bouncer at a night club on weekends, sales jobs, Uber driving, insurance and real estate licenses, part-time remote teaching, tutoring, and consulting

CMA: Achieved a CMA through IMA while in the Johnson & Johnson Finance Leadership Development Program

Coding Portfolio: I have uploaded videos of completed coding projects, such as a custom-built proprietary cashflow ledger, budgeting system, and BI utility, which I designed and developed without any 3rd-party, nor code-producing support, such as AI and human assistance, which can be found here: <https://wellintell.us/resources#budgetinganchor>. My decision was to include javascript only as optional, activateable by a click of a button and not exposed to users by default, and only if there was a utility that was deemed to have additional value by adding javascript. The result and rationale is that using only static-page code, such as PHP, and not including any other front-end aside from HTML/CSS is more reliable with more definitive database interactions.

International Culture and Human Behavior: I have tremendous experience with international cultures, having lived as a nomad and resided outside the United States for nearly 10 years, including having studied abroad during college which involved months of travelling throughout Southern Europe during and after the program, which was funded from playing Texas Hold'em poker professionally several days a week at a local casino near campus. **My nomad experience includes many places less-traveled by US citizens, including the rainforests of the Borneo Island and Amazon. 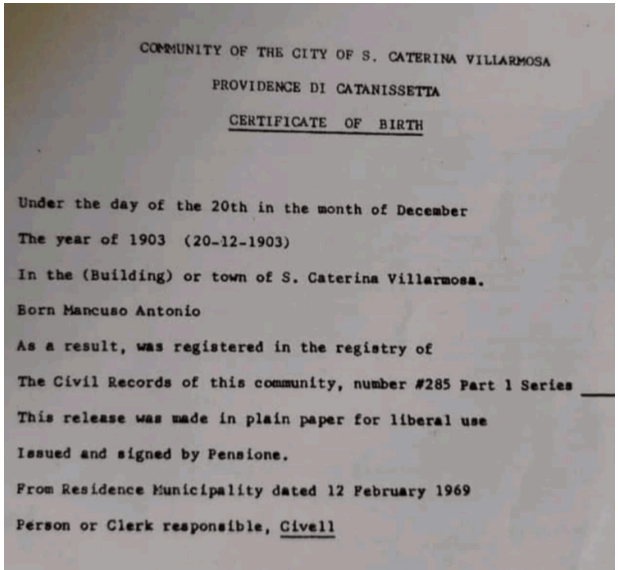

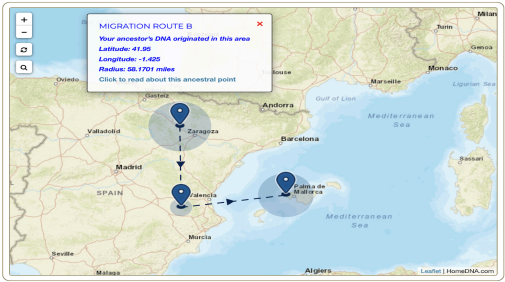
Certificate of birth verified at government Comune office in Sicily granting Italian dual citizenship rights eligibility

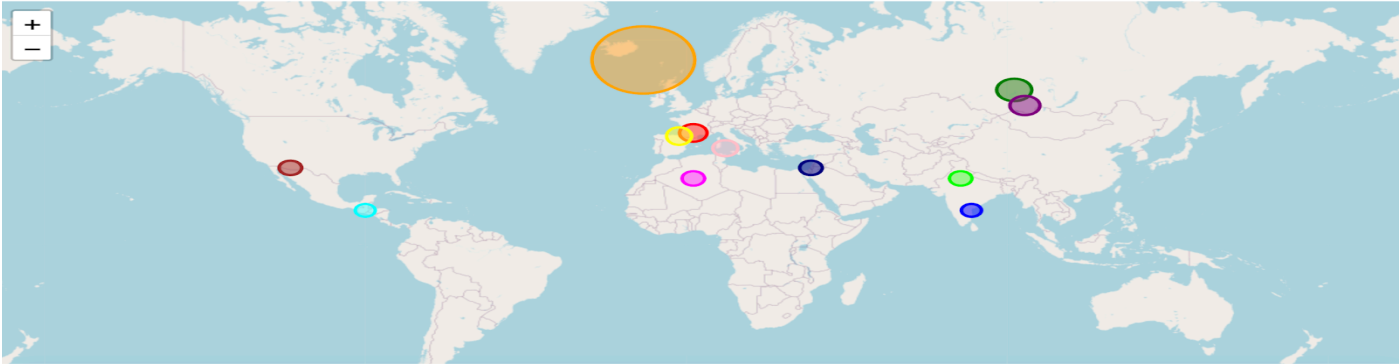

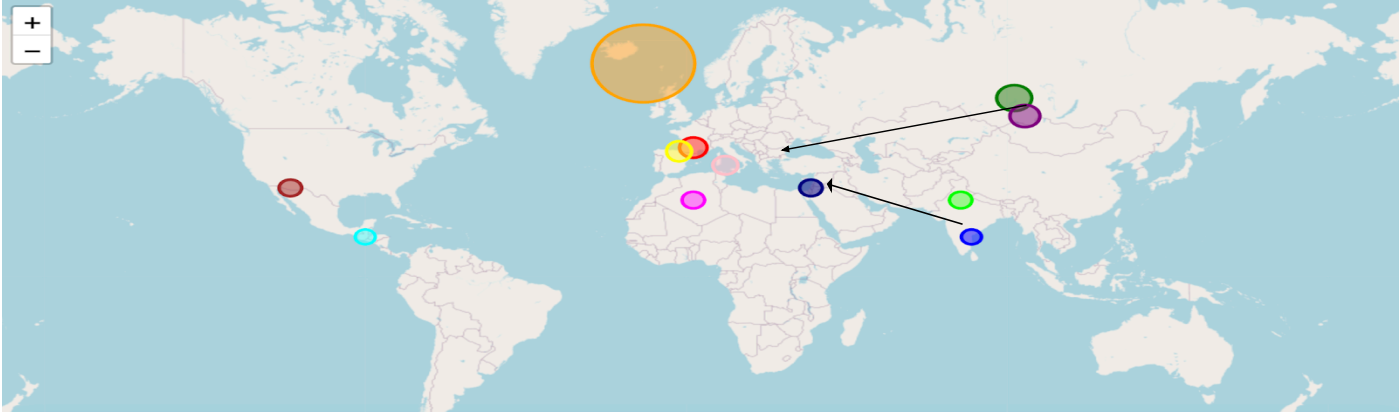

findings: patient had a through and through 1 inch laceration of segment 4b. The liver edge to the laceration was ligasured and all actively oozing vessels suture ligated with 3-0 prolene sutures. the free edges were then reapproximated with a 0 chromic suture in a U-suture fashion. a 10 F flat JP drain was placed over the liver laceration and a piece of omentum pulled up in between the liver and stomach. All 4 quadrants of the abdomen, the lesser sac, and the retroperitoneum was surveyed to be hemostatic.

procedure in detail: The patient was transferred directly from the ED resustative room to the OR. Once in the OR, the patient was expedately prepped and draped in the standard fashion. A surgical pause was initiated and the abdomen was opened with a bovie electrocautery. The patient was hemodynamially stable at this time, without any hard evidence of vascular injury in the right neck. Once the abdomen was entered, there was frank blood visible. Blood clots were evaucated and all four quadrants of the abdomene were packed. Anesthesia was then allowed to continue their resustative efforts, and the patient was seen to be hemodynamially stable, only with a few points of softened systolic blood pressures. The falciform ligament and the penetrating stab wound was. There was found to be a 2 cm liver laceration in segment 4b that was actively bleeding. The other quadrants were also sequentially removed of packs and found to have no injuries. The bowel was run from the ligament or trietz to the IC valve and the colon as well was examined and free of any injuries. The stomach also was found to have no leak intraabdominally. Attention was then returned to the liver laceration, which was cauterized with the ligasure device, and opened towards the apex. Any franky bleeding arterial and venous blood vessels were subsequently suture ligated with 3-0 prolene sutures. The raw free edges of the liver were then bovied. Once hemostasis was insured, the free edges were reapproximated with a 0-chromic suture on a blunt needle, paying close attention to catch the liver capsule with each suture bite. we subsequently opened up the lesser sac with a bovie, and made sure to see no injuries in the reptroperitoneum. The intestine was then run again to confirm the absence of injuries. The left stab wound that penetrated the peritoneum was re-examined, and the peritoneum was approximated using a 3-0 vicryl suture in a figure of 8 fashion. the abdomen was subsequently washed out with warm irrigative fluid. a 10Fr flat JP drain was then placed above the liver bed, and a piece of omentum placed between the stomach and inferior liver surface. The abdomen was then closed using a 0 loop maxon suture. skin was stapled. and a dry dressing applied superficially. At the end of the case, the right neck continued to be stable, the patient continued to be hemodynamially stable, and so was transferred to the ICU in stable condition with plans for CTA of the neck to rule out any neck vascular injuries.
